





Notes to the accounts

- Volunteer Trustees and low costs tiny budget
- Costs tightly controlled
- Dip in total income due to lower large donations and fund-raising income
- Increased donation this year to St Mark's for research - £5000.
- Sufficient cash to cover a year's costs.
- Robust financial processes in place, exceeding requirements for a charity of this size.

Member vote

- Members to accept the 2023 accounts & to progress the audit (independent verifier)
- Proposer, seconder, vote

Transition from an Association of Members to a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO)

- CIO Transition voted AGM 2022
- Trustees wish to progress in 2024
- Process:
 - New Constitution (approve and lodge with CC)
 - New bank account (new legal entity)
 - New charity ("Red Lion Group") set up at CC
 - Transition from existing RLG to new RLG

New Constitution based on the model constitution required by the Charity Commission

- Proposed Constitution circulated with AGM documentation to all Members
- The same charity objectives and substantially the same clauses as the previous Constitution
- Same voting process, same Trustee reelection, same quorum rules, same number of trustees, same powers over resources etc

Member vote

- Members to accept the new Constitution as an essential requirement for transition to a CIO
- Proposer, seconder, vote
